Dr. Williams previously served as the CEO of Community of Science Inc., a Johns Hopkins spin-off company that matched researchers with funding opportunities on the World Wide Web. He has worked as a strategy consultant in the fields of biotechnology and media and held executive positions at American Broadcasting Companies and the Gannett Center for Media Studies in New York.

Dr. Williams earned a B.A. at Yale College and a D.Phil. at Oxford University, where he was a Marshall Scholar.
